### **NSSGA** Was a Critical Part of History



- NSSGA was one of the leading advocates for the bipartisan Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- \$1.2 trillion included highway reauthorization and key infrastructure investment for the future in water systems, broadband, trains and aviation
- Attended bill signing November 2021

- 2.44 billion metric tons in 2022
- 459 million metric tons in Q1
- 137 Producer members
- 9000 facilities
- 100,000 employees

# **US Recycled Aggregates**



- Consistent over last 4 years at around 30 33 million metric tons
- Road surfaces made of asphalt concrete and portland cement concrete surface layers, which containcrushed stone aggregate, were recycled on a limited but increasing basis in most States. In 2022, asphalt and portland cement concrete road surfaces were recycled in all 50 States.
- Increasingly, recycled asphalt and portland cement concretes are being substituted for virgin aggregate, although the percentage of total aggregate supplied by recycled materialsremained very small in 2022.
